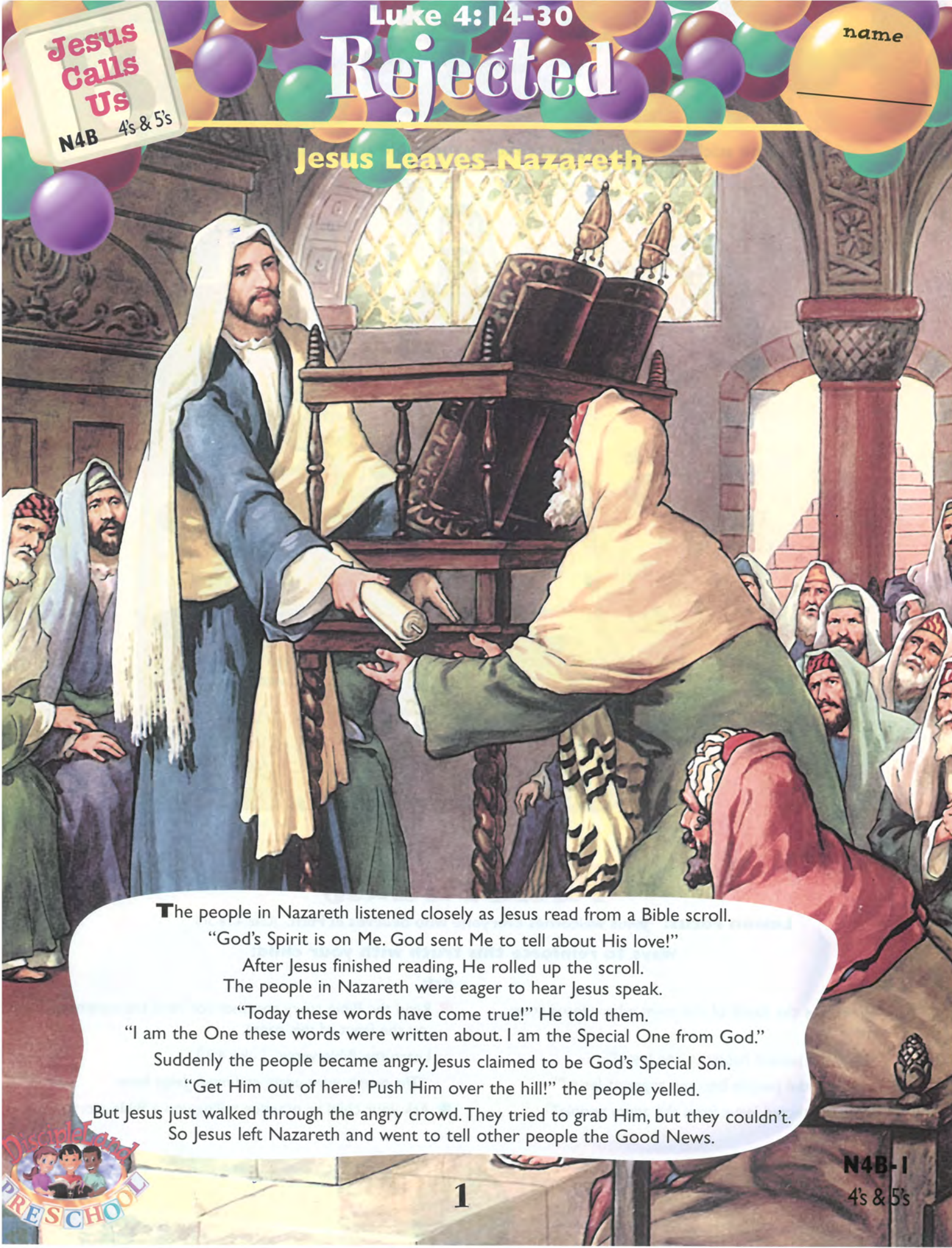

Jesus Leaves Nazareth

Ask:

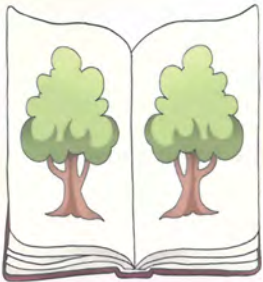
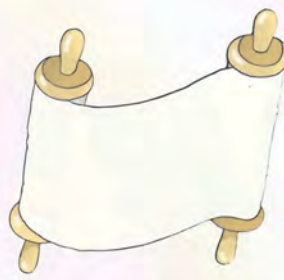
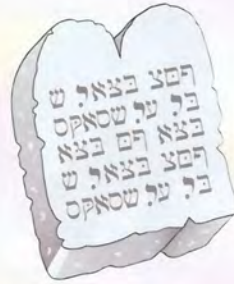
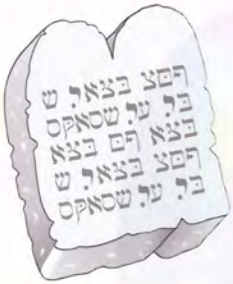
- "What was the name of the town where Jesus grew up?"
- "Were the people happy to see Jesus?"
- "Why did the people become angry at Jesus?"
- "Who protected Jesus from the angry people?"

Act:

- Read the Bible story together (or read the summary on the front of this page).
- Learn the Bible verse: Luke 4:29.
"The people were angry and made Jesus leave."
- Ask your child to practice telling you a Bible story.
