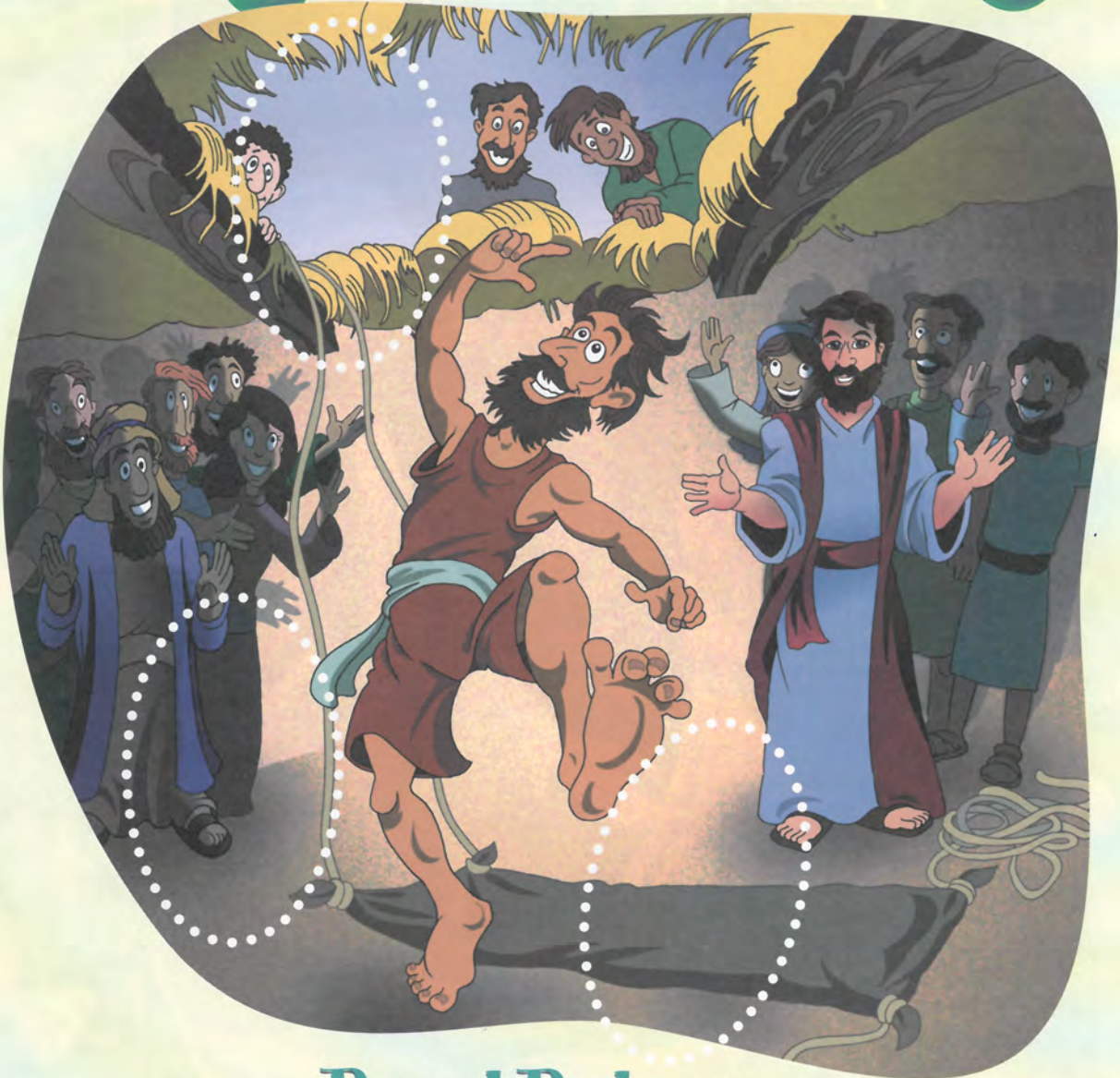
Jesus Heals a Paralyzed Man

- “What did Jesus do to help him?”

Act:

- Read the Bible story together (or read the summary on the front of this page).
- Learn the Bible verse: Luke 5:26.
“Everyone was amazed and praised God.”
- Talk with your child about a time when you needed to be forgiven.

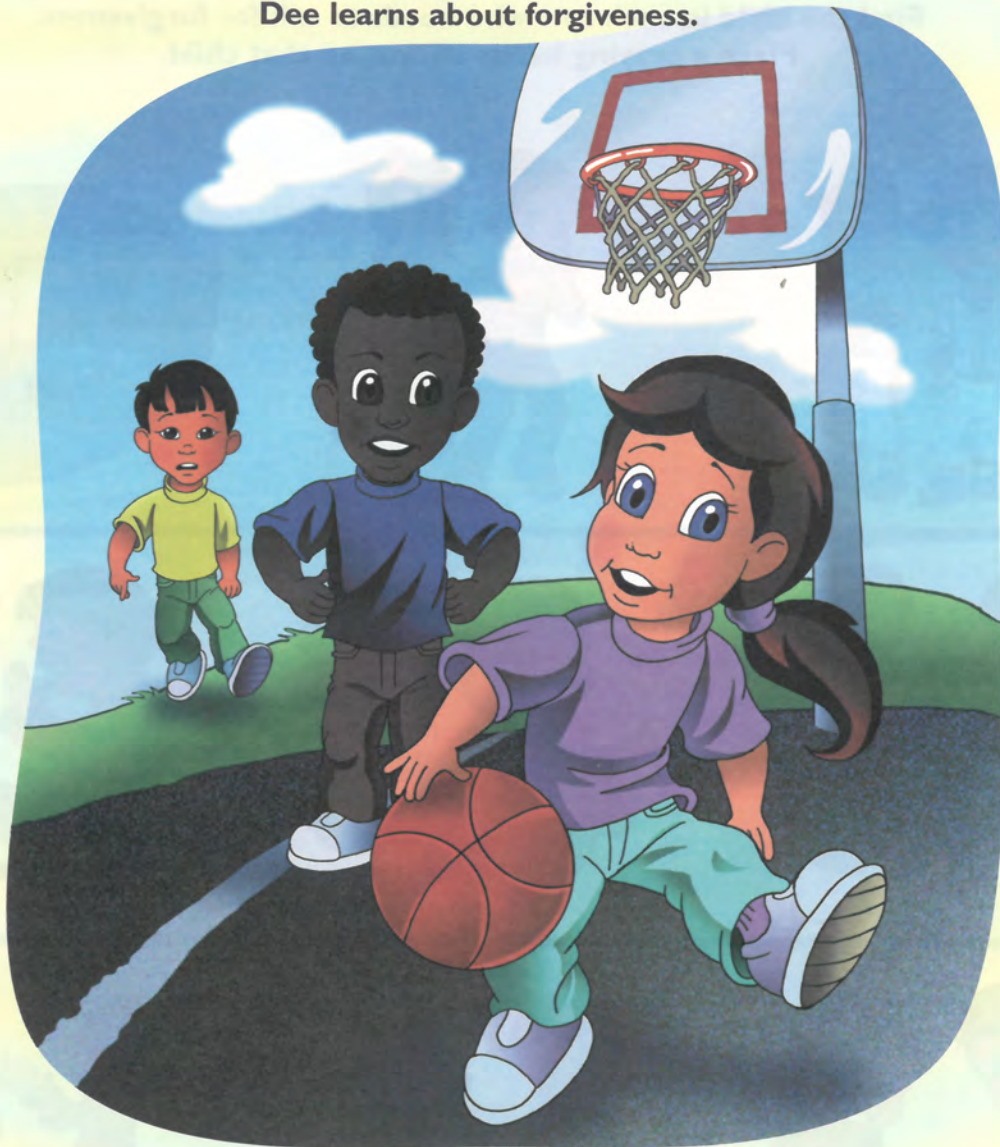
Forgive Me
