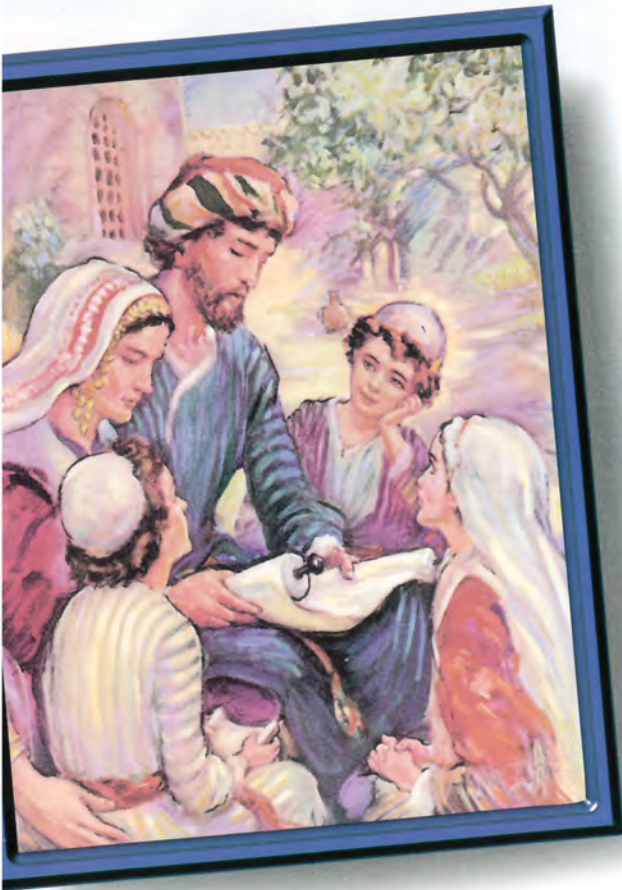


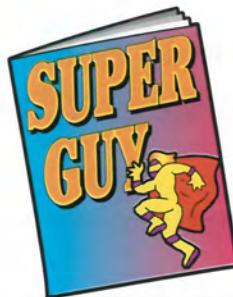
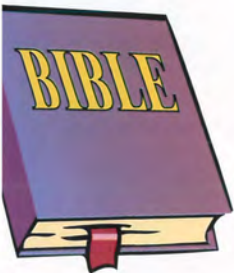


The Bible Enters My Mind

Circle the ways that God puts His Word into our minds.





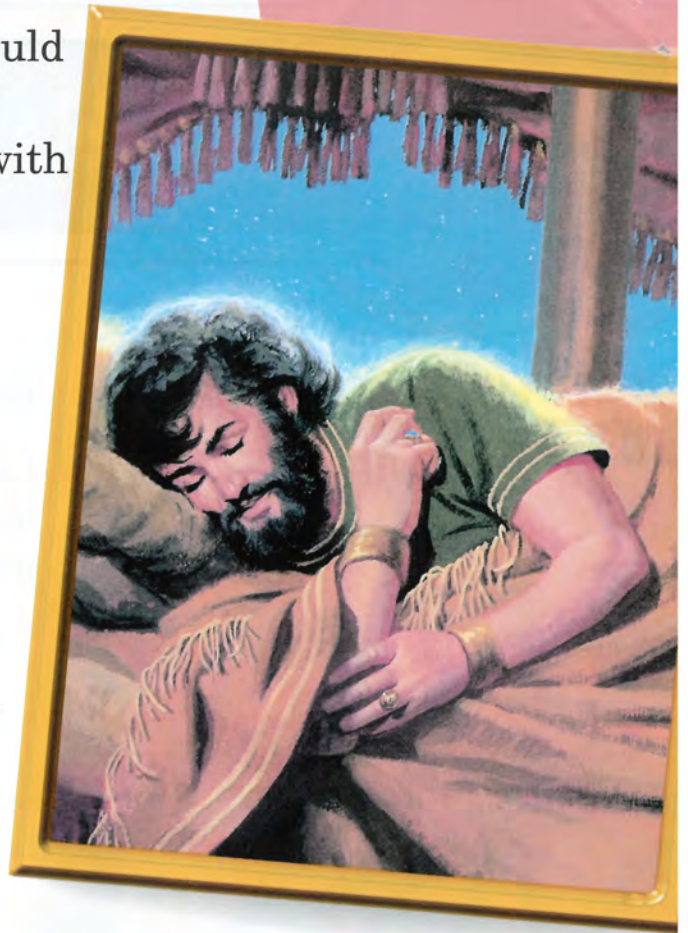
• God told Solomon he could ask God for *one* thing.
